He is a Circles of Trust® facilitator in association with Parker J. Palmer and the Center for Courage and Renewal.

## Sample Offerings

#### Faculty & Staff Professional Development

- Faculty/Staff Retreat to reflect on identity, purpose, and calling as educators, and on how to support students' exploration of vocation.
- Professional Development Seminar to encourage integrative approaches to addressing societal needs and cultivating lives of commitment.
- "Cultivating the Courage to Lead®": a yearlong professional development academy on living and leading with greater authenticity, effectiveness, and wellbeing.

#### Campus Ministry & Spiritual Life

- The "Big Questions, Deep Listening" Project invites students to reflect on Big Questions of vocation and identity, faith and values, spirituality and justice.
- "Sabbath" retreat offers time, space, and permission to recalibrate our relationship with time, and renew our capacity to be present.

#### Students, Student Organizations, & Student Life

- Key transition points, including "The Big Questions" first-year students), "STOP" (Sophomores Thinking on Purpose), and "What Should (or Could!) I Do with My Life?" (juniors and seniors).
- Leader Development to cultivate reflective, "insideout" leaders for the common good and explore connections between leading, service, and social justice.
- Civic Engagement & Community-Based Learning to deepen a campus-wide culture of inquiry, meaningmaking, and reflection in teaching, learning, and scholarship.
- \* "Stepping it Up: Peer Mentoring in Vocation, Service, & Leadership Among College Men" supports male students to be reflective, contributing citizens of campus & community.
